Agricultural Land Trust (ASX: AGJ)


One Managed Investment Funds Limited (**OMIFL**) as responsible entity of the Agricultural Land Trust (ASX: AGJ) (**AGJ** or **Fund**) requests an immediate halt to the trading of the Fund's ordinary units quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**).

In accordance with Listing Rule 17.1:

1. The trading halt is necessary to assist the Fund in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as it expects to make a price sensitive announcement to the market in relation to the recently announced financial statements.
2. AGJ requests the trading halt remains in place until the earlier of the commencement of normal trading on Wednesday 4 March 2020 or when the announcement regarding the finalisation of investigations are released to the market.
3. OMIFL is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
