Request for Voluntary Suspension Agricultural Land Trust (ASX: AGJ)

One Managed Investment Funds Limited (OMIFL) as responsible entity of the Agricultural Land Trust (ASX: AGJ) (AGJ or Fund) requests a voluntary suspension of the quotation of the Fund's ordinary units quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX).

In accordance with Listing Rule 17.2:

- 1. Further to the Fund's request for a voluntary trading halt on 2 March 2020 (**Trading Halt Request**), the Fund is not in a position to make an announcement at this time and requests a voluntary suspension to assist the Fund in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as referenced in the Trading Halt Request.
- 2. AGJ requests the suspension remain in place until the earlier of the commencement of normal trading on Monday 9 March 2020 or when the announcement regarding the finalisation of investigations referred to in the Trading Halt Request are released to the market.
- 3. OMIFL is not aware of any reason why the Fund's securities should not be suspended or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the suspension.
